- _____ 6. Research Plan/Approval Form and Checklist/Safety Assessment Form were completed and attached to entry form.
- _____ 7. All certification forms for working with humans, vertebrate animals, tissue, recombinant DNA, pathogenic agents and controlled substances were properly completed and submitted, if necessary.
